Your application has been received and arrangements have been made to help you in the next step towards naturalization. Please come

to the office of the Clerk of the District Court at Pueblo, Colorado  
on MAR 8 1962 at 1:45 P.M. The proceeding will take about two hours. If for any reason you cannot keep this appointment, return this letter immediately with your explanation and a request for a new appointment; otherwise, no further action will be taken on your application.

If you are applying for citizenship for yourself, you will be tested concerning your knowledge of the government of the United States and its history. You will also be tested on your ability to read, write, and speak English, unless on December 24, 1952, you have been living in the United States for a total of at least 20 years and were then over 50 years old.

Be sure to bring with you these six items, as well as what is checked below and on the reverse side:

1. This letter
2. Alien registration receipt card(s)
3. Any draft card(s)
4. \$10 in (cash) (postal money order made payable to the Clerk of Court for filing fee)
5. Any documents you have which you used in connection with any entries into the United States
6. Two witnesses who are citizens of the United States, and

☒ who have seen you frequently for as much of the past 2 years as possible

☒ who have frequently seen you and your child (children)

☐ who have frequently seen you, your spouse, and your adopted child (children)

☐ who can identify you as the person named in your discharge certificate(s)

Your witnesses, unless born in the United States, must bring with them proof of their United States citizenship. If they have not known you for the entire number of years stated, you should be prepared to give the names and addresses of two additional witnesses who know you well and have seen you frequently in the places where you have lived during the remainder of those years. Arrangements will later be made to take the sworn statements of these additional witnesses for the remainder of the period. Witnesses other than native-born citizens should bring with them their naturalization or citizenship certificate. Please have your witnesses read this paragraph.
