

SUBJECT: Indefinite Term Appointment of Reserve Officers in the USAF

TO: Second Lieutenant James P. Moss, A0 591005, USAF

1. The Armed Forces Reserve Act of 1952 was enacted 9 July 1952 by the 82nd Congress. This Act requires that all Reserve Officers not holding indefinite term appointments on 9 July 1952 be afforded an opportunity to accept an indefinite term appointment in lieu of their current five-year term appointments.

2. The indefinite term appointment will be in the same grade and service number as your current five-year term appointment. You must indicate by first indorsement within 60 days from this date your acceptance or declination of the indefinite term appointment as a Reserve Officer in the United States Air Force.

3. Inclosed is a letter of appointment as a Reserve Officer in the United States Air Force together with AF Form 133, "Oath of Office". Completion with signature of the two copies of the first indorsement, properly executed oath of office, and expeditious return of this correspondence, except original copy of the letter of appointment, will constitute your acceptance of this indefinite term appointment. In the event you decline to accept this indefinite term appointment, so indicate on the first indorsement and return this correspondence without further action. The term of your current five-year appointment will not be affected by your declination, and your appointment will expire on the fifth anniversary of the appointment or on 1 April 1953, whichever is later.
